#### **USAGE INSTRUCTIONS**

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE** – read instructions carefully.

AquaFinesse<sup>™</sup> must be used with an approved sanitizer of choice.

### START UP INSTRUCTIONS for use with sanitizing tablet kit

- 1. Drain hot tub completely after running AquaFinesse Spa Clean to purge lines in older tubs. Run garden hose for 60 seconds before filling the tub with fresh tap water. **For new tubs:** Run garden hose for 60 seconds before filling the tub with fresh tap water.
- 2. Balance tub water including Alkalinity, PH and total hardness.
- 3. Shake the bottle of AquaFinesse™ to mix the solution. Pour the correct amount of AquaFinesse™ (as indicated in the manual) into the water. Turn on the jets for a minimum of 2 minutes to activate the AquaFinesse™ water care system.
- 4. Place (1) sanitizer tablet in the slow-release dispenser, close cap, fill with water and place dispenser directly on the top of the filter (basket). Check dispenser every week to make sure tablets are intact. Replace tablet when gone or as needed. Chlorine reading should be 1.5 3 ppm.
- 5. Rinse filter once a week to ensure total sanitation and clean your filter with AquaFinesse filter clean once a month.

## START UP INSTRUCTIONS for use with sanitizing powder kit

- Drain hot tub completely after running Spa Clean to purge lines in older tubs.
   Run garden hose for 60 seconds before filling the tub with fresh tap water.
   For new tubs: Run garden hose for 60 seconds before filling the tub with fresh tap water.
- 2. Balance tub water including Alkalinity, PH and total hardness.
- 3. Shake the bottle of AquaFinesse™ to mix the solution. Pour the correct amount of AquaFinesse (as indicated in the manual) into the water. Turn on the jets for a minimum of 2 minutes to activate the AquaFinesse™ water care system.
- 4. Add one tsp of granules directly to the water and with jets running. Chlorine reading should be 1.5 3 ppm.
- 5. After each use of the hot tub add one half tsp of granules directly to the water and with jets running. If the tub is not in regular use this amount can be reduced to one tsp of granules at least once a week.
- 6. Rinse filter once a week to ensure total sanitation and clean your filter with AquaFinesse filter clean once a month.

# **ONGOING WEEKLY MAINTENANCE**

Repeat steps 2 - 5 for tablet kit and 2 - 6 for powder kit on a set day, every week.

# **MONTHLY**

- 1. We recommend that you have a water sample taken to your retailer for water balance and hardness testing.
- 2. Clean your filter with AquaFinesse Filter Cleaner.

## **SPA SAFETY**

- To avoid possible health hazard to users, never heat spa water above 104° F (40°C). The spa use should be limited to 15 minute intervals to avoid nausea.
- Do not enter a spa under the influence of alcohol or medication that could cause drowsiness. If you are on medication consult a doctor before using the spa.
- Because of high water temperatures, pregnant women and small children should use caution.
- Do not use electricity near the water. Example: radios or hairdryers.
- Hot water is an ideal medium for spreading infection. People with open wounds should not use the spa.
- Always enter and leave the spa with caution.

# **CHEMICAL SAFETY**

- Read the directions carefully.
- ALWAYS add chemicals to water, NEVER add water to the chemicals.
- Do not mix chemicals together. Add chemicals one at a time. Rinse out and dry the measuring cup before the addition of the next chemical.
- Store chemicals in a cool, dry place. Keep the container closed when not in use.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not ingest.
- Do not smoke near chemicals.
- If bottle is empty, discard in trash or offer for recycling if available.

### **FIRST AID**

 If swallowed in undiluted solution, drink large amounts of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. In case of accident or illness, seek medical attention immediately.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

The AquaFinesse™ system ensures pure, clean water and releases old dirt, calcium and scale build up from pipes and equipment inside your hot tub. This process may cause water to appear cloudy during the first few weeks of use. Continue using product as directed; after this process is repeated 2 or 3 times, your water will be clear, clean and free of any greasy or slimy feeling. Always clean filters.

# **SUGGESTIONS:**

- purchase an additional filter element and rotate filters regularly
- take a simple shower before taking a hot tub bath
- do not use oil-based salts or smelling agents
- ensure 8 hour per day circulation programming
- after big bather load (party) check Alkalinity as it may drop
- if sanitizer is depleting quickly and low sanitizer tests occur, switch to granular sanitizer
- after heavy bathing loads, add Spa Shock
